10. **ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULT OF CLUSTER 4 SPECIAL ELECTION**

Member Moss announced that Cluster 4 (Diamond Bar, El Monte, Industry, La Puente, South El Monte) met prior to the start of the governing board meeting for a special election to fill the remaining term for executive board alternate. She announced that Member Hector Delgado (South El Monte) was elected to serve as executive board alternate.

11. **NOTIFICATION OF CLUSTER 2 AND CLUSTER 3 ELECTIONS**

Recommendation: Receive notification of Cluster 2 and Cluster 3 elections to be held on May 29, 2026.

Christina Lopez, Board Secretary, presented this item.



Notification was provided to Cluster 2 (Azusa, Covina, Irwindale, Baldwin Park, Glendora, West Covina) and Cluster 3 (Arcadia, Bradbury, Duarte, Monrovia, Pasadena, Temple City) of the upcoming elections for executive board member and executive board alternate for each cluster. The elections will take place on May 29, 2026. The newly elected executive board members will serve a three-year term, which extends through May 2029.

The Governing Board received notification of Cluster 2 and Cluster 3 elections to be held on May 29, 2026.

12. **FINANCIAL FORECAST**

Recommendation: Receive and file the update to Foothill Transit's financial forecast for fiscal year 2027.

Lallaine Gayton, Budget and Grants Manager, presented this item.

Ms. Gayton reported on the financial forecast, which summarizes operating and capital revenues and expenses from Fiscal Year 2022 - 2031. Operating expenses are fully funded through Fiscal Year 2030 and the current capital program is anticipated to be fully funded.

Staff responded to comments and questions regarding funding for transportation services for the 2028 Olympics.

The Governing Board received and filed the update to Foothill Transit's financial forecast.

13. **REQUEST TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED CHANGES TO COMMUTER EXPRESS SERVICE**

Recommendation: Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to seek public input and conduct a public hearing regarding the proposed changes to Commuter Express Service.

Josh Landis, Service Development Manager, presented this item.

Mr. Landis reported on the six commuter express service lines that have been closely monitored as the Covid Pandemic impacted these lines due to shifting working hours and employees working from home. Commuter express service ridership remains at about 38 percent of pre-pandemic levels. Proposed changes include combining routes and improving overall system efficiency. If approved Foothill Transit plans to reinvest savings into weekend service.



Since the proposal involves the cancellation of three commuter express lines, it is required that a Title VI analysis and public hearing be conducted. Staff has identified six locations to have meet the planner discussions with customers and a Public Hearing will be held at the Foothill Transit Administrative Office in May 2026. Customers will also be able to participate in a virtual meeting. Feedback can also be provided a via email, and information will be provided in multiple languages. Final recommendations will be considered by governing board at their August 2026 meeting.

Staff responded to questions and comments regarding the status of the Fairplex Park-and-Ride and the availability of an online form that customers will be able to use to provide feedback.

Motion by Member Calaycay, second by Member Lloyd, to approve. Motion carried 21-0.

14. **2026 Foothill Transit Bus Roadeo Results**
